for children in Romania

The misery in thousands of villages in Romania is indescribable large. After the collapse of the communism, the land is still influenced by large unemployment and lethargy. Now inside the European Union, hundreds of thousands children suffers in bitter poverty in Romania. In the countryside they collect nuts, mushrooms, berries, etc. to have some food or sell it for little money. Often they live in little huts of clay and wood, without proper roof, windows and doors. In the cities they early get into difficulties as street kids with drugs, alcohol and prostitution. Here children sleep on the roadside or underground in the sewage system.



Crop failures and hard wintertime hit mostly the poor people. Above all, children suffer under malnutrition, lack of hygiene and seasonal clothing. Barefoot in the snow is often seen, as well as ragged clothes, mat hair and big hungry eyes.
